Payment of fees

The BMAT entry fee is £42.50 per candidate entered within the EU (including the UK) plus a local administrative fee. Open Centres charge an administrative fee to candidates who are taking the BMAT at an Open Centre. The administrative fee is payable directly by the candidate to the Open Centre. The administrative fee would cover costs such as room hire and invigilation costs. The Open Centre at which you are registering will be able to notify you of their administrative charge. Reimbursement of fees

If the entry fee is going to cause you financial difficulty and you are a UK student in receipt of: the full Adult Learning Grant (ALG), or Income-Based Job Seeker's Allowance, or Income Support, you can apply for the BMAT standard entry fee to be reimbursed. EU candidates in receipt of equivalent allowances or grants in their home country may be entitled to reimbursement. Please contact the BMAT Support Team for more information.
